What is covered under the InterNACHI Inspection Warranty Premium Plan?

HVAC	main central, heating/central, cooling/heat pumps, & water heaters	other heating sources or accessories (fireplaces, wood-burning stoves, thermostats, humidifiers, sensors, etc.), solar systems, window units, condensate lines, and pumps, & other systems not specifically listed
Plumbing	primary interior water, drain & vent piping	all secondary or distribution piping, fixtures, faucets, shower pans, sump pumps, & other systems not specifically listed
Electrical	interior electrical panel(s) & wiring	exterior service, alarm or security, any utility service, smart home, electronic devices, & other systems not specifically listed

Any element, system, or component reported in the home inspection report as malfunctioning, deficient, or needing repair, or not functioning as intended or not reported at all is excluded. The program provides reimbursement for eligible repair expenses associated with the failure of covered appliances or systems, mold remediation, roof leak repairs, or foundation structural claims as specified in the terms and conditions. Reimbursements range from \$500 to \$2,000 per claim, with a maximum aggregate policy limit of \$3,000 per client. This means that regardless of the number of claims submitted, the total reimbursement to any one client will not exceed \$3,000. If we determine, after investigation, that repairing an appliance, system, or major component is not feasible, the program will compensate the client with up to \$500 toward a replacement. Roof repairs will be reimbursed for expenses in excess of \$250 per claim, up to a maximum of \$500.

What's Covered?

Our warranty covers a wide range of essential home systems and potential issues, with specific limits for reimbursement.

- HVAC, built-in appliances, and primary plumbing line repairs, are reimbursed up to \$1,150 per repair.
- Structure, electric, sewer lines, and mold removal are reimbursed up to \$2,000.
- Roof leak repairs in excess of \$250 are included up to **5 years** from the date of inspection, with a limit of **\$500** per repair.
- 11-month warranty inspections are also included.
- Properties with multiple structures or duplexes are eligible for coverage.
- Townhomes and Condos are eligible for coverage.

What's Not Covered?

Some items are not included in the warranty:

- Any elements that were reported as **deficient** or not working as intended during the initial inspection.
- Items that **could not be inspected** at the time of the inspection.
- New construction that has never been lived in.
- Repaired items. If an element was noted as deficient on the inspection report and was
 later fixed, we won't cover it. We recommend that the company that performed the repair
 guarantee their own service.
- **Sewer lines** are only covered if the inspection company performed the scope of the inspection, not a third party.

How Long Does Coverage Last?

The standard warranty lasts for **120 days** from the inspection date or **90 days** after closing, whichever comes first. However, roof repair coverage extends for up to **5 years** from the inspection date.

I have a home warranty do I need an Inspection Warranty too?

The Inspection Warranty is the perfect complement to a full home warranty which often doesn't cover the home buyer until 30 days after closing. In addition, the Inspection Warranty is tied to the

findings of the inspection and the elements inspected. The Inspection Warranty covers things like Roof leaks, Mold and Structure which are not normally covered in a full home warranty.
